Avalon Sustainable Summer School is a two week learning experience for young people (aged 14 and above) combining adventure, art and skills for sustainability in an international, English-speaking environment. The camp is held within a beautiful protected wilderness area in the foothills of the Spanish Pyrenees. The camp is led by a team of experienced outdoor guides, educational facilitators, and language coaches.

This action-packed camp offers a choice of outdoor activities (rock climbing, canyoning, trekking and archery), art activities (photography, video, dance and sculpture), and community development skills: how to work in a team, express your thoughts, communicate with different people and face new challenges.

Avalon offers a time and place for intercultural exchange, sharing values, learning new skills and having fun. Students will be taking part in a pioneering education for sustainability program. For non-native English speakers, it is a fantastic opportunity to be immersed in the language. For native English speakers, there is a wonderful chance to be exposed to new languages, both Spanish and the languages of new friends from around the world.
